### ICCR Africa Scholarship Scheme 2022-2023.

ICCR has announced the ICCR Africa Scholarship Scheme for the academic year 2022-2023. The last date for uploading the applications is 31 May 2022.

2. The scholarships include full tuition fees, a monthly stipend or living allowance, a house rent allowance, a one-time thesis and dissertation expense, and a return economy class air fare to the nearest airport and 3<sup>rd</sup> AC train fare to the place of study if so required.

3. Applicants must be 18 years of age at the time of admission in Indian Universities/Institutes and not more than 30 years of age. A valid passport for the duration of the course is essential for successful submission of applications.

4. Detailed guidelines for the process of applying for the scholarship and rules and regulations governing the grant are available from 25.01.2022 on [www.a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in](http://www.a2ascholarships.iccr.gov.in). All interested candidates are required to register at this portal with a valid email ID which they will be using during the duration of their academic relationship with ICCR. Thereafter applicants must submit their application with true copies of all relevant documents as required by the A2A portal.

5. Interested students are advised to visit the relevant websites of the Universities/Institute and do a thorough research on general information of courses offered, eligibility criteria and browse their preferred course and institutes of study. Students may also refer to the Universities Handbook on the University Grants Commission's website <https://www.ugc.ac.in> to make their choices. Applicants may apply with 5 Universities/Institutes in descending order of preference. ICCR will grant admission to eligible applicants as per the order of preference indicated by the applicant. It may be noted for B.Eng & B.Tech courses, physics, Chemistry and Mathematics (PCM) are compulsory in grades 11 and 12 and is a mandatory requirement for Engineering courses.

6. Students are to ensure they have obtained a equivalence certificate from Association of Indian Universities (if required) as this would be stipulated by the concerned University as a mandatory requirement,(more information available on <https://evaluation.aiu.ac.in/student/login>) and bear the fees at own expense (non-reimbursable). 7. For students who secure a scholarship it is compulsory to procure a medical insurance policy on their own capacity with minimum sum assured for India Rupees Five Lakhs (INR 500 000/-) which is equivalent to about \$6800/- per annum. This is to highlight that ICCR will not be offering medical coverage to its students.

8. Rejected candidates will be informed directly by the University/Institution.
